The top 5 rules of reader-friendly writing.

- 1. Put your main idea up front—don't bury it in the details.
- Let's plan an off-site!
 I'd like to invite our entire team, and
 do it outside. You're great at planning
 events—can you help?
- I'm not sure but...
 I think maybe I'd like to do something outside, maybe something off-sitey.
 Don't really know who to invite but I know you've been involved in planning things before so maybe that's an option?
- 2. Make it easy to scan-not a wall of text.
- For this exercise, you'll need a:
 - Collaborative doc, like Dropbox Paper
 - · Whiteboard tool, like Miro
 - · Piece of paper

There are a number of things you will need in order to complete this exercise. First, you will need to gather a collaborative doc like Dropbox Paper as well as an online whiteboard tool such as Miro, and potentially a piece of paper.
